MEMORANDUM

Re: Life Insurance

16th December, 1942.

TO: Mr. R.P. Alexander,
 FROM: Mr. S.M. Gibson

I am attaching hereto files as indicated above. Attached to each, excepting the last two noted above, is correspondence from the San Life Assurance Company in connection with payment of money to Japanese persons with respect to surrender values of Life Insurance Policies. As for the last two files mentioned, Nos. 6343 and 2185, I dealt with the matter as per copy of my letter of December 14th in those files.

I have been instructed verbally in connection with this matter but if I am to be responsible to instruct the San Life or any insurance company in connection with payment of money to persons of the Japanese race, I would appreciate receiving definite written instructions in line with your policy concerning this.

I am afraid that at the present time we might overlook or not know about claims against some of these people, and if in such cases it later is found that they owe money and I have instructed the insurance company to pay funds out to them, I may find myself in an awkward position.

As a matter of fact, as I see it, this is not a matter to be dealt with by this Department at all. We are not responsible for Life Insurance but we are instructed to pay premiums when asked by the Policyholder to do so and providing that he has left the policy with us for safe-keeping or has declared it, and also providing that he has funds on deposit here with which to meet the cost of that Life Insurance.
