



GENERAL SUMMARY

File 1630.

This 65-year old Fisherman, a Naturalized Canadian, from Quathiaski Cove, signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form March 19th, 1942. According to affidavit on file this evacuee was born Sankichi OZAKI, being adopted into and taking the name of his wife's family on the 25th December, 1904.

His wife, Kiku (File 6360) signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 24th April, 1942.

They were evacuated on May 21st, 1942. Files show there were 4 children over 16 and 1 under, who were presumably evacuated with their parents.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: See Real Property Summary for particulars of Quathiaski Cove property (Cat. 539) sold for \$2,000.00.

Personal Property: See Chattels Schedule (to follow) for particulars of Chattels.

Specified Articles: See Fishing Vessel Summary for particulars of F.V. "Miss Seymour" sold by this office for \$250.00.

See Fishing Vessel Summary for particulars of an old F.V., the "Quathiaski #1", used occasionally for bait, not fishing, and beached by Navy as of no value. \$200.00 was recovered from the Navy (Apr. 5/45) for this condemned vessel, the amount less expenses (\$4.50) being credited to this account.

Accounts Receivable: None.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: None.

Bank Accounts: Evacuee declared a balance of \$1,711.84 in an account (No. E-80) with Canadian Bank of Commerce, Campbell River, and a balance of \$412.97 in an account (No. 1529) with Bank of Montreal, Main & Hastings Sts., Vancouver, neither of which were disturbed by this office.

Life Insurance: None.

Liabilities: None.

Funds: The balance standing at the credit of this account at this date is \$1,758.30.
