
Chattels: 1 sewing machine, 1 cook stove, 3 chairs, 2 beds, 1 crib, kitchen utensils and chinaware, 2 trunks and tools declared, were shipped to Mrs. Doi by Matt Brown on September 21st, 1942 with the exception of 1 cook stove (which was sold to a chinaman by Mrs. Doi prior to evacuation) and beds and crib which were considered of no value.

The same tools were declared by both Kenichi Doi and Sumiko Doi and have been shipped to Doi as per Matt Brown report of September 21st, 1942 on file 4852.

Re: DOI. Sumiko (Mrs. Kinichi) Reg. 06194.

Mrs. Kinichi DOI who resided in a house owned by the Royston Lumber Co. at Cumberland declared 1 cook stove, 3 chairs, 2 beds and 1 crib left in the house. She also declared kitchen utensils and chinaware, set carpenters tools, 1 double bit axe, 2 trunks of clothes left with the Royston Lumber Co. and a Singer Sewing Machine left in your care.

Her husband, Kinichi Doi, Reg. No. 06195 declared a sewing machine, No. 2 Wicker basket containing miscellaneous goods, among them tools and the axe, and No. 3 Box containing kitchen utensils and dishes.

You reported to us on September 21, 1942 that all goods of value had been shipped on June 15th. and we have on file a Custodian Release from which we note that No. 2 Basket and No. 3 Box as well as the sewing machine were shipped. It is possible that the two trunks declared by Mrs. Kinichi were the same as No. 2 and No. 3 basket and box or that they were separate trunks which were shipped previously, and we would ask you to clarify that point if at all possible.

In your same report of September 21st. you stated that the stove had been sold to a Chinese before evacuation and that the crib and 2 beds, of small value, were stored in the house. No mention was made of the 3 chairs nor have we any record of the beds and crib having been sold since then. Could you let us know what happened to these goods.
