This file reveals that Mrs. HARAFUJI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. HARAFUJI made her declaration to the Custodian on April 28/42 and was evacuated on Sept. 8/42. She declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule consisting of 2 boxes, one trunk, 2 wash tubs, and a tub of shoyu sauce. The contents of these boxes, etc. are given on Chattel Schedule. Everything with the exception of the box of kitchen utensils was shipped to Mrs. HARAFUJI. The box of kitchen utensils was shipped from Cumberland to Vancouver on June 4/45. (See letter from Mr. Matt Brown dated April 8/46). The contents of this box were sold at Vancouver auction #63 for the net sum of \$6.26 and this sum credited to her account with the Custodian. No chattels are declared or dealt with on the file of Mr. Saichi HARAFUJI.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: Mrs. HARAFUJI declared \$70.00 in War Savings Certificates in the possession of her husband. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: She declared an account in the Royal Bank of Canada at Cumberland in the sum of \$300.00. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
