
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This man, who was evacuated on September 10, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 28, 1942.

In his declaration, he reported ownership of a trunk, containing clothing and musical instruments, and a tool box, all left at Cumberland, B. C. The file indicates that the trunk and box of tools were shipped to Shinsaburo FUJIOKA.

He also declared a \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

In addition to the items declared, the file reveals that the account of this man was credited with the sum of \$3.05. This was a refund of one per cent wage deductions received from the Provincial Government. This sum was remitted to FUJIOKA on January 19, 1944.

The account of Shinsaburo FUJIOKA has been credited with the sum of \$10.51 from the proportionate share of the assets of Royston Savings Association on the basis of three shares. The share certificates are on file.

This file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.

Dear Sir:

This is to advise that the sum of \$10.51 has been credited to your account with this office, as proportionate share of the assets of the Royston Saving Association. This sum will be sent to you if you will send us the three Share Certificates of the Association, which we assume are in your possession.

In your declaration to the Custodian on April 28, 1942, you reported ownership of a trunk and a box of tools left at Cumberland, B. C. These articles have since been shipped to you.

The Victory Bond, which you declared, was in your own possession at the time of your declaration. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

In January, 1944, we remitted to you the sum of \$3.05, which had been received from the Provincial Government as refund of one per cent wage deductions for the year 1941.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and, in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
