This man, who was evacuated on September 10, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 28, 1942.

In his declaration, he reported ownership of a trunk, containing clothing and musical instruments, and a tool box, all left at Cumberland, B. C. The file indicates that the trunk and box of tools were shipped to Shinsaburo FUJICKA.

He also declared a \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

In addition to the items declared, the file reveals that the account of this man was credited with the sum of \$3.05. This was a refund of one per cent wage deductions received from the Provincial Government. This sum was remitted to FUJIOKA on January 19, 1944.

The account of Shinsaburo FUJIOKA has been credited with the sum of \$10.51 from the proportionate share of the assets of Royston Savings Associatio on the basis of three shares. The share certificates are on file.

This file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.
