Dear Sir:

We have removed the remittance in the amount of \$52.44 which was incorrectly applied to the family of Shigeru Hamaura to that of Takasha Hamaura. However, this amount represents an annual remittance.

Under our Yearly Payment Plan for Intermediate policies, credit for a full year is allowed if a payment equal to 95 per cent of the sum of 12 monthly premiums is made within thirty-one days of the due date of the monthly premium.

As this remittance was originally received in November 1943, which was beyond the grace period, we could not credit the remittance on the annual basis.

If the premium payer will forward the arrears from March 1943 to and including November 1943, which amounts to \$36.80 this amount together with the remittance in the amount of \$52.44 would pay the premiums to and including November 1944. This additional remittance should be forwarded as promptly as possible, if credit on the annual basis is desired.

The \$52.44 which has been applied to these two policies only pays the premiums to and including February 1944 with a balance of \$1.84. Therefore, we believe it is to the insured's advantage to forward the additional remittance as promptly as possible.

We are under even date forwarding a copy of this letter to Takasha Hamaura.

Assoon as the entries in the premium receipt books of Shigeru Hamaura have been adjusted they will be returned to you.
