The above Japanese recently applied through the Security Commission for shipment of a trunk left with Mr. G. Singh, 577 Mitchell Road, Trigg Island, B.C. Mr. Fisher is arranging this.

Mr. Masso Tsukakawa did not declare anything left behind, but his wife did declare furniture, household effects and kitchen utensils, left in the care of the Sawarne Lumber Company at House No. 543 Mitchell Island. We understand from the official of the Lumber Company that there is nothing there now except the trunk which will shortly be shipped and we assume, therefore, that everything else was disposed of prior to evacuation.

For our own record, we would mention that the lumber company official told us the Japanese had left no other effects at Mitchell Avenue.
