MEMORANDUM TO FILE 6541

June 20, 1944

Moriharu TANIGAMI, Reg. 03429 & JFVDC Vessel File 439.

This man was declared to the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee as being the actual and licensed owner of the fishing vessel "M.T." Vancouver 1291.

The "M.T." Vancouver 1291 was licensed in the name of Moriji TANIGAMI, File 6543, father of Moriharu.

The net proceeds of the sale of this vessel were paid to "M. Tanigami" on April 14, 1942. The amount being \$641.00.

It is not known which of these men received the money, but the signature resembles that of Moriharu more than that of Moriji.



Dear Sir:

This is just to thank you for your two letters of March 23rd and 26th telling us of your difficulties.

We have already sent you \$75.00 for this month (mailed on or about March 16th) and have no doubt this has now been duly received.

We are enclosing herewith a statement of the nets that have been sold for you. The entire proceeds have been credited to your name. We had to do this because, although both you and your son declared nets and lines, these were only tagged "M. Tanigami".

Our enclosure shows total sale of \$853.50 and our remittance on March 16th has reduced this to \$778.50. Before we can make another remittance we shall need a letter signed by you and your son, Moriharu, stating that future monthly remittances of \$75.00 may be made to you, or, alternatively, advise us how much is to be sent to you and how much to your son.

We have not forgotten your jointly signed letter of July 29th last year which read, "I would appreciate it if you would send my father's net funds to him and my net funds separately from his to the above address."

We think you will understand now that we cannot do this until you have advised us which nets belong to whom. That is why we have made the suggestion set out in the preceeding paragraphs.

Thank you for yours of April 12th acknowledging receipt of our cheque for \$75.00 and requesting that a similar remittance be made monthly. We are ready to do this but remind you of what we wrote on March 31st. You will recall that we said that as we could not distinguish between your and your son's nets, we could only send the proceeds to you on receipt of a request signed by both of you.

It will, therefore, be necessary for you to write us a letter somewhat on the following lines.

"My son, Moriharu, has agreed that the entire credit from the sale of nets belonging to the Tanigami family and not separated in our account with the Custodian, may be sent to me at the rate of \$75.00 per month."
