This file reveals that Mrs. HAYASHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATTELS:

Mrs. HAYASHI made her declaration to the Custodian on April 27/42 and was evacuated on May 30/42. She declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file, some left in house #10 Chemainus, and some at the Japanese Hall, Chemainus. Mr. HAYASHI declared exactly the same list of chattels as Mrs. HAYASHI.

4 Boxes of effects, those left at the Japanese hall, were shipped to Mrs. HAYASHI on May 21/42.

The chattels left at House #10 were inventoried as shown on Chattel Schedule. One bed, one table, and one chair, inventoried by the Custodia are missing, or may have been discarded as of no value. The balance of goods inventoried were sold at auctions Chemainus #1, Nanaimo #2, some being credited to the account of Mr. HAYASHI and some to the account of his wife, as indicated on Schedule. The total sum credited to the account of Mr. HAYASHI was \$24.24 and the total sum credited to the account of Mr. HAYASHI was \$6.82.

2 tables, carton of ladies' hats, festival dolls, and bdle of axe, saws and hammer, declared by Mr. and Mrs. HAYASHI, were not found by the Custodian.

A sleigh, cabinet and shelf, not specifically declared, were sold and credited to their accounts.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
