

GENERAL SUMMARY

Mrs. SAKAMOTO made her declaration to the Custodian on April 27/42 and another on June 23/42. The list of goods given in the first declaration is more detailed than the list given in June. However there is no indication on file that the goods were ever looked for at 836 E. Cordova St. Nothing seems to have been done about them whatever. The husband, File 11840, declared no chattels and there is nothing on his file regarding same. Nothing is declared by either of the daughters, Hiraye or Mitsuko, files 14455 and 15564.

I wrote to Mr. Babcock from whom the SAKAMOTO'S rented the premises at 836 E. Cordova St. and he advised in his letter of the 13th instant that he had no knowledge of any goods of any kind whatsoever at these premises and stated that they were rented to them entirely unfurnished.

She declares a \$2000.00 policy with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.
