This file reveals that Mrs. FUJIMOTO owned no real property in any protected area of E.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: Mrs. FUJIMOTO made her declaration to the Custodian on April 27/42 and was evacuated on May 4/42. She declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule on file at 526 E. Cordova St. and some at 242 Princess St.

Chattels were inventoried at 526 E. Cordova St. on Aug. 28/42 and removed to 992 Powell St. The following articles inventoried by the Custodian are missing:

The 3 chairs declared by Mrs. FUJIMOTO were not found. The goods inventoried, other than those mentioned above as missing, were sold at auction for the net sum of \$42.64 and this sum credited to the account of Mrs. FUJIMOTO.



None of the goods on this inventory, with the possible exception of the counter and cabinet sold on the file of Mrs. Y. FUJIMOTO, File 6599, are accounted for. Actually no chattels were found at 242 Princess St. in the name of Mrs. Seki FUJIMOTO. No chattels are dealt with on the file of her husband, File 14737.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
