Further to my memorandum of Dec. 1/42. and for the purpose of record, I wish to state that many Japanese left their chattels stored in the establishment mentioned above.

In the execution of my duties, my investigations necessitated several interviews with the Fathers and Sisters in both buildings.

On my early visits I stressed the fact that all Japanese chattels were vested in the Custodian, and that we required inventories from them covering all Japanese chattels left in their care.

To the best of my knowledge they have not complied with our requirements, and their attitude was one of ignorance, or complete indifference to our wishes. This non-cooperative attitude has frustrated our attempts to control and protect.

I would further venture to surmise that they have effected shipments of chattels to Japanese without our permission.

Knowing the meticulous care exercised by their religious organizations to protect the interests of their adherents, I concluded they resented our activities and regarded them as interference.

Dear Madam:

We have received from Mr. Yataro KONISHI receipt for the radio which has been sold in your name for the net sum of \$77.98 for which amount we now enclose Custodian cheque which will close your account in this office.

Your file has been reviewed and the following has been noted:

When you registered with the Custodian you declared 3 Beds, 7 Chairs, 1 Table, 2 Bureaus, 2 Carpets, Wardrobe, 2 Gas Ranges and 1 Stove at 439 Powell St. When Mrs. Teruko KAJIOKA registered, on June 23, 1942, she advised us of a change in the disposition of your chattels and reported the following articles moved to the Catholic Church Hall, Dunlevy Avenue, Vancouver: 1 Table, 5 Chairs, 2 Kitchen cabinets, 1 Pail of chinaware.

We assume that these articles are still in the Catholic Church Hall and that you disposed of your other articles prior to your evacuation.

You declared \$90.00 in War Saving Certificates in your own possession, and these certificates therefore did not come under control of the Custodian.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
