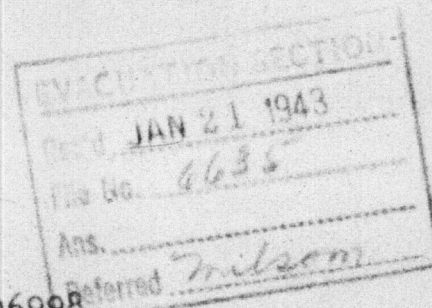

1. That I owned and had in my possession at Fanny Bay, British Columbia, one R.C.A. Victor Radio, 7 tube mantel model radio, #B5 Serial No.328, short wave.
2. That I surrendered this radio to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police on February 22, 1942, and obtained a receipt therefor.
