

In looking over Mr. OKADA's file I see that you placed a value of between \$500.00 and \$600.00 on a small dwelling belonging to the above named which is located on land belonging to the Victoria Lumber Company.

The owner apparently carried no insurance and as far as I can tell it has not been occupied excepting for the three weeks that you rented it to some fisherman as per your letter of August 6th, 1944.

While this house is standing vacant and as the owner carried no insurance it is not our policy to place it; but if it should be rented at any time in the future it would be necessary to place fire insurance to protect up to its present insurable value. I would ask you kindly to contact this Department should you have occasion to put a tenant on this property.

Re: Personal Property.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant asking for information regarding personal property left by you at Chemainus.

Our records show that, with the following exceptions, all these goods have either been shipped to you or sold. The exceptions referred to are: (1) gramophone records, (2) paint (1 tin), (3) floor covering. The first, valued by you @ \$3.00, were probably found to be unsaleable and consequently discarded; there is no trace of the second, a 1 gal. tin of paint, valued by you at \$4.00; and the third was probably left in the house, as having no separate sale value.

The house erected by you on land owned by the Victoria Lumber & Manufacturing Co. Ltd., was taken over by the Company, who, as you know, recognise no outside equity in such property and have demolished a number of these standing in the way of considerable extensions made to their plant.

For your information we enclose an extract of your account, showing a balance of \$93.00 standing at your credit at the present time.
