GENERAL SUMMARY

Satoru TANIGUCHI, Dec'd.

Satoru TANIGUCHI drowned at Henderson Lake, Alberta, on July 18, 1943 at the age of twenty-two years. He is survived by his father, Kizo, file #8609, his mother, Koyote, file #7580, and five brothers.

The deceased declared no assets to the Custodian but, upon his death, this office was advised that he had a \$1000.00 Life Insurance policy in the Sun Life Assurance Company under which his father Kizo was the beneficiary. A cheque for \$1000.00 was received from the Insurance Company on December 13, 1943, and credited to the account of Kizo TANIGUCHI in this office.

A claim was filed against the deceased for the sum of \$150.00 to cover funeral expenses of the deceased. This claim was paid from the death benefits derived from the insurance policy upon the authorization of Kizo TANIGUCHI, the beneficiary.

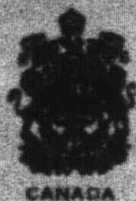




