GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 6819

Re: Toyaji OZAKI, Reg. No. 05774

This man was a restaurant operator at 362 Powell Street. He was evacuated on May 5, 1942.

In the declaration to the Custodian, which Toyaji OZAKI signed on April 29, 1942, he reported the following chattels left at 362 Powell:

1 Gas Range	2 Carpets	1 Kitchen Stove
9 Tables	1 Sink	1 Heating Stove
30 Chairs	1 Hot Water Tank	
1 Electric Clock		

According to an undated memorandum on file, Mr. Trumbull visited these premises and found a few chattels there, securely locked in one large room, which was considered safe and satisfactory storage. On January 19, 1944, OZAKI requested shipment of the following boxes, which he said were stored in the Continental Daily News Building, 213-215 E. Cordova. On January 27, 1944, this office handed to the B.C. Security Commission for shipment to OZAKI 16 boxes of household effects.

It is possible that the only chattels not disposed of by OZAKI before his evacuation were those contained in the 16 boxes, and that the chattels reported by Mr. Trumbull were those of someone other than OZAKI. Apart from the 16 boxes shipped we have not been informed by OZAKI of any chattels belonging to him having been stored at the Continental Daily News Building.
