Dear Mr. Secretary:

Re: Policy No. 1,057,375

We have received your letter of May 8th asking us to let you have a cheque for the current dividend of \$14.00. This cheque has been sent to-day to the office of the Custodian here. You may expect to hear from them promptly.

Now may you feel that as you prepaid the first three premiums on your policy in March, 1942, you should receive a reasonable rate of interest even though maturity is not until 1945. The policy by its terms provides that if you have the necessary premium payments you will receive \$2000.00 on April 10, 1945. In 1942 you chose to pay that year's premium and two in advance. In view of this you were allowed a discount of \$14.00 on the prepaid premium. This represented interest at the rate of 4% per cent per annum and is the only discount or interest that you are entitled to because the prepaying of premium does not in any way affect the maturity value of your policy.

With reference to the claim amounting to \$1,970.00 which you lodged with the Custodian against the above named.

We wrote to him about your claim and he replied as follows:-

"I have duly received yours of the 21st ult. in regard of the above named claim amounting to \$1,970.00 against me. Some twenty five or six years ago I have built a gas boat named "Cecil" with companionship the above named elder brother who died about twenty years ago, and on account of business disaster our companionship had broke.

"I gave a promissory note to the deceased widow under the condition if I have succeeded in my business I will pay out the note amount to her but thence I have been broken myself, therefore she never claim to me since.

"About 8 years ago the claimant came to me with that note, and I told him I don't owe him any money at all and in the meantime that note has eliminated law term already, therefore, I have no duty to pay any.

"I wish you will leave the case alone, I will fix up myself between him past war when I have chance to see him."

As this claim is outlawed we cannot do anything more about it.
