Her husband, Eitaro (File 4022) signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 13th April, 1942. He was evacuated on the 12th September, 1942.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Personal Property: Declared no chattels, "as they were listed in husband's registration" (File 4022). However, on undated Custodian Release form, Mrs. Aida, requested shipment of 3 trunks, which were duly shipped by Matt Brown on May 24/42.

Specified Articles: None.

Bills Receivable: None.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: A Victory Bond (\$100.00) and War Savings Certificate (\$100.00) declared to be in owner's possession, did not come under the administration of this office.

Bank Accounts: A balance of \$800.00 (reported by Bank to be \$676.83 on Jan. 31/47) declared to be in Royal Bank of Canada, Cumberland, did not come under the administration of this office.


Life Insurance: None.
