GENERAL SUMMARY

File 1838

October 2, 1947

Re: Tsutomu OZAKI, Reg. No. 11402

This man was evacuated on August 22, 1942. He had been working at Ocean Falls, B.C., but at the time of his declaration to the Custodian, April 29, 1942, he was living with his parents at 362 Powell Street. These premises belonged to the M.KADO Estate, Enemy 549.

Tsutomu OZAKI declared that he had left at 362 Powell Street, the following chattels:

School Books and Supplies valued at \$65.00  
National Encyclopaedia 12 volumes  
Dictionary 3 volumes  
1 Six-plate Gurney Wood and Coal Range \$50.00 (declared July 11/42)

On January 27, 1944 there were handed to the B.C. Security Commission for shipment to Toyaji OZAKI, father of Tsutomu, 16 boxes of household goods, which at that time were stored at the Continental Daily News Building. It is possible that all the goods left in the protected area by the OZAKI family were those stored at the Continental Daily News Building and that all these goods were shipped on January 27, 1944. Apart from the fact that no inquiries have been received from this family in regard to their chattels there is no evidence that all their chattels have been shipped. No chattels identified as belonging to this family were removed from 362 Powell Street. XX

Tsutomu OZAKI declared \$35.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These were not brought under the control of this office.

The sum of \$7.61 representing refund of 1% Provincial Wage Tax for 1941, was received and was remitted to Tsutomu OZAKI on March 29, 1943.

XX. On March 17, 1945, Tsutomu OZAKI was informed that our investigators had been told that he had disposed of the stove and books, declared to have been left at 362 Powell, prior to his evacuation. No reply was received from OZAKI, and it is assumed that he and his parents did remove their goods from 362 Powell St. before their evacuation.
