This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 29, 1942. She was evacuated on May 5, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a bed, a looking glass, a trunk a box of kitchen utensils and a singer sewing machine left at Mayne Island, B.C. The sewing machine was shipped to the husband of this woman in December, 1942 and the remainder of the chattels appear to have been sold at auction on December 1, 1943 and the net proceeds credited to the account of this woman's husband, File No. 5135.

The father of this woman died and the account of this woman was credited with the sum of \$95.55 as her share of the estate of her father. We are today remitting this amount to her.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
