GENERAL MEMORANDUM

Re: Tsuiko NAKAMURA, Reg.No.06227

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 29, 1942. She was evacuated on May 3, 1942.

In her declaration Mrs. Tsuiko NAKAMURA reported ownership of Box #1, containing personal belongings as per list attached and valued at \$175.00. Box #2 containing clothing, coats, comforters, classical books, etc. valued at \$135.00. These boxes were stored with Mr. & Mrs. Gordon Horne, Union Bay, B. C. Mr. & Mrs. Horne acknowledged holding these goods in acknowledgment filed on File No.4849, the file of Kiyoshi NAKAMURA, Husband of Tsuiko NAKAMURA, who also declared the goods. Mr. Matt Brown on November 2, 1942, reported that he had checked with Mr. Horne and considered that the goods were in safe hands.

Mrs. NAKAMURA reported a Metropolitan Life Insurance Co. policy, No. 82628566, in her own possession. This was not brought under the control of this office.

No other property of any kind is revealed by this file.
