This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 28, 1942. She was evacuated on June 22, 1942. In her declaration she stated that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in the protected area.

A copy of the Chattel Schedule covering the goods reported by Sadaichi TAHARA, husband of this woman, has been placed on this file. It is noted that Trunk #3, reported by the husband is listed in Custodian Release dated March 2, 1943, signed by Asa TAHARA. It is assumed that this trunk was shipped, as there is no evidence to the contrary on file.

The only items not satisfactorily accounted for are the Trunk #3, (and this it is reasonable to assume was shipped as requested by Mrs. TAHARA); the stove pipes, which were probably discarded as valueless and the bath, which probably was left in the house.
