
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

GENERAL SUMMARY

The above, who registered with the Custodian on April 28/42, signed a yellow "No property" card stating that she owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. However on Oct. 26/42 she signed a statement giving a list of goods that were left at 77 Powell St., Vancouver, and stating that if these goods were not sold the key to this place would be brought to the Custodian by the declarant before she left. She was evacuated on Oct. 30/42. On Dec. 21/42 we wrote to her and advised her that none of her property had been found at 77 Powell St. and that we therefore assumed that she had either taken them with her or disposed of them before her evacuation. We received no reply to this letter. There is therefore nothing on this file for which the Custodian need care.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

In your registration with the Custodian, you declared no personal property on April the 18th, then on October the 26th, you declared, barber's chair and other equipment at 77 Powell Street.
