



PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: KUWAORI, Kisanō (Mrs. Tadashi) - Reg. No. 01103.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian, to the effect that she had no property of any kind in the protected area, on April 28, 1942 and was evacuated on May 8, 1942.

CHATELS: We wrote to inquire whether she had any barber equipment left in Vancouver but she replied that she had none. However, Mr. Isamu SHIGEMATSU of SHIGEMATSU TRANSFER declared that he was holding, for a group of Japanese who were being evacuated to Greenwood, 16 stoves and miscellaneous chattels. One of these was marked "Mrs. K. KUWAORI" and as the above is the only person of this name in our files and was evacuated to Greenwood, it is assumed that the stove was her property. It was sold by auction for the net sum of \$3.96. The file does not reveal what happened to a saw which was listed on the inventory, at the same time as the stove.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
