

Mr. Ito states that there was no definite legal arrangement with Saichi ITO (now at Lethbridge, Alta.) who is both his uncle and his Father-in-law. There was a verbal arrangement that Shigery 170 would purchase ten acres of the farm owned by Saichi ITO, Mr. Saichi ITO, also built on the 10 Acre 10t, a house for the use of Shigeru ITO and his daughter, who is the wife of Shigeru ITO.
