We wrote Mr. Shimizu several times regarding this claim but he has never replied to our letters. Mr. Shimizu has no funds at credit with the Custodian.

As Mrs. Shimizu declared this debt in her JP Form and had funds credited to her account from the sale of chattels we transferred the sum of \$100.00, being the total amount at credit in her account, to N. Nishiguchi Company Limited account No. 11519.

Mrs. Shigehiro declared, in her JP Form dated April 15, 1942, leaving effects with Dunshire Evans, File No. 732, at 1020 Queens Avenue, New Westminster, B. C., and also declared leaving household effects at her sisters place, Chito Kimura, File No. 3849, on Ferguson Road, New Westminster, B. C.

Mr. Bardwell made a list on May 14, 1942, of the effects left at 1020 Queens Avenue by the above-mentioned but stated that he could not identify any of her household effects left at her sisters house as they were mixed in with Mrs. Kimura's effects and were listed in her report.

New Westminster Trust Company on July 30, 1942, also made a list of the effects left at 1020 Queens Avenue, New Westminster, B. C., by Mrs. Shigehiro.

Mr. Shigeichi SHIGEMOTO did not declare personal effects to the Custodian but on several occasions he requested different articles left at Mrs. Kimura's he sent to him at Raymond, Alberta. Three shipments were made and freight charges were paid by Mr. Shigehiro direct.

Net proceeds derived from the sale of effects belonging to the Shigehiro's and left at 1020 Queens Avenue amounted to \$11.55 and said amount was credited to Mrs. Shigehiro's account No. 4077 in this office.

The following effects were auctioned on January 28, 1944, but were not declared by the Shigehiro's nor were they inventoried but proceeds from same have been credited to the above account.

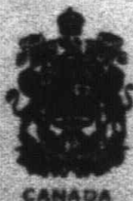
