
MEMORANDUM.

Re: Hidekazu RYOJI, Reg. #13763, Deceased.

The above Japanese person died at Toronto, Ontario on October 10, 1946. He declared to the Custodian on April 30, 1942 that he had \$80.00 owing to him by R.H. Palmer, Whitehorse, Yukon, and had in his possession five \$5.00 War Savings Certificates and had paid \$12.00 on a \$50.00 Victory Bond, and also a \$1000.00 twenty year endowment Sun Life Insurance Policy, of which the beneficiary was his father, Kazuta Ryoji.

The file indicates that he was part owner with his father of a motor vehicle surrendered to the Police, but against which was a Lien for more than its appraised value. The car was accordingly surrendered to the Lien-holder with nothing salvaged.

Claims were filed against the Deceased in the sum of \$30.60 by the Royal Columbian Hospital, New Westminster, and \$46.00 by Dr. G. Morse. Both these claims were paid by the father of the deceased some time in 1945. A letter written to the deceased inquiring whether the claim against R.H. Palmer of Whitehorse had been paid did not receive a reply and therefore no further action was taken by the Custodian in this connection.
