PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Yoshizo IRIZAWA - Reg. No. 10850

CHATELS: The above Japanese registered with this office on the 30th April, 1942, at which time he declared leaving household furniture, farm tools and carpenters tools left in the house belonging to T. YOKOYAMA, which he was renting at Haney.

Our fieldmen inventoried this property on the 17th November, 1942, and they made note at the time that some of this man's chattels had been moved by him prior to evacuation to another man's house so as not to be spoiled. IRIZAWA was asked to give particulars of where they were stored but no reply was received, and no further action taken by this office.

All saleable chattels on the property were sold by public auction on the 16th December, 1943 for the net sum of \$31.18.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: The sum of \$3.52 was received at this office to IRIZAWA's credit being a refund of his 1941 Provincial Income tax.

BONDS & INVESTMENTS: Yoshizo IRIZAWA declared owning a \$50.00 Victory bond and some War Savings certificates, but these were not brought under control by the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT & SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX: IRIZAWA declared a bank account and safety deposit box at the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver, B.C., but these were not brought under control.

LIFE INSURANCE: He also declared owning two Sun Life Insurance policies, but these were not brought under control by the Custodian, although cheques in the amount of \$169.50 and \$6.86 were forwarded by the Insurance Company through this office.

This file reveals no other personal property assets.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.




