Your file has come under review and we take this opportunity of giving you a brief summary of our administration of your affairs.

You declared no real property to the Custodian as being registered in your name as your property had been transferred to your two sons, and therefore, none was administered under your account.

Prior to your evacuation the property registered in the names of your sons, was leased by you from the 1st June, 1942 for a period of eight months, and the consideration of \$525.00 was partially paid to you in cash at the time and the balance was paid in the form of a post-dated cheque in the amount of \$249.14. This post-dated cheque was collected by the Custodian and the funds credited to your account.

Dr. G. Morse filed a claim against you for \$26.54, and upon your acknowledging the account as being correct in your letter of the 20th March, 1943, payment was made from your account at this office.

Beatty Bros. Limited and the Maple Ridge Co-operative Union originally notified us of outstanding liabilities by you, however, both were withdrawn as you had apparently made settlement in full with them prior to your evacuation.

You declared yourself to be the holder of shares in the Maple Ridge Co-operative Union, but we have perused their records and were unable to find any confirmation of the fact. If you have documentary evidence to substantiate your interest in this Co-operative, please forward them to this office as soon as possible so that this matter can be checked as the Co-operative is at the present time being liquidated.

When making your declaration to the Custodian you stated you were the holder of Victory bonds, War Savings Certificates and a \$10.00 share in the Consumers' Co-operative. You also declared that you had a bank account at Haney and were renting a Safety Deposit box in which was left a Family Benefit Society insurance policy. None of the above however, were brought under control by the Custodian.

Attached hereto please find a statement of your account at this office showing the credit balance to be \$72.60. A cheque in this amount is being forwarded to you through the Department of Labour and you should receive it during the course of the next few days.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every

kind left by him in the Protected Area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.


