The camera about which you enquired, is in our hands, and may be sent to you if you will send us the receipt which was given to you by the police when the camera was surrendered. The cost of mailing the camera will not be great -- a few cents -- and we have ample funds to your credit to cover the cost.

The funds standing to the credit of your account total \$6.24, and represent the refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941, which were paid in to this office on your behalf by the Provincial Collector, Vancouver. This money is available to you.
