PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 9, 1946.

Re: Edward MOCHITSUKI, Reg. No. 15491

This man signed two declarations to the Custodian, one on March 31, 1942 and the other on April 30, 1942.

In his declaration of March 31, 1942, he reported 2 suitcases of personal clothing in his possession at Hastings Park. These were ~~of course~~ *no doubt* were taken with him on his evacuation and should not have been declared.

In his declaration of April 30, 1942, he reported a 7-ft. skiff left at Ucluelet. H. G. Hinton reports that this was not found and if it were left on the beach it was probably stolen.

In both declarations he reported a \$5.00 War Saving Certificate in his own possession. However, Mr. Wheadon *cautious* found a certificate in this man's *at Hinton Bay* name and on our inquiring of MOCHITSUKI if he still had the Certificate in his own possession he advised he could not find it. We therefore forwarded *DM* his certificate to him. This did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.

Re: Edward MOCHITSUKI

This file may be regarded as closed. The first registration of March 31st, 1942, declared two suitcases of personal clothing in the owner's possession. These were obviously taken with him and should not have been declared. The second registration dated April 30th, declares a skiff valued at \$5.00 which Mr. Hinton, as per Page 2 of duplicate registration, could not locate. The Japanese was so advised on July 24th, 1942. In view of the small value involved, this matter should not be followed further.
