



We, therefore, enclose the above Company's cheque in the sum of \$37.92, and would ask you if Mr. Iwasa has no claims against him if you would kindly forward this amount.

We have not the Christian name or any additional information to help you identify Iwasa, but he was one of the principal employees of The Royston Lumber Company Limited, and we understand he was evacuated to the Bridge River area.
