In reply to your letter of the 21st instant, we beg to advise you that since our report to you covering the affairs of Yoshio HATANAKA, dated June 20th, 1944, his share of the rentals from 2152 Marine Drive, West Vancouver, in which he has a one-half interest, have ruined his balance with the Custodian from \$147.97 to \$208.92. As previously reported, this man has claims filed against his accounting to \$218.95.

We are endeavouring to obtain a purchaser for the West Vancouver property, but to date our efforts have not met with success. An independent appraisal on our file indicates that the property has a value of \$2000.00.
