Mrs. KOSAKA wrote to this office on the 30th October, 1943, asking that the proceeds from the sale of her washing machine be sent to her. It was found that this washing machine had been sold under File No. 6981, Robert Jiro KOSAKA, and upon confirmation from him that the funds belonged to MRS. KOSAKA, the sum of \$160.00 was remitted to her.
