Teruko Sunada died in the Provincial Mental Hospital at Essendale, B. C. at the age of twenty-five years. She was survived by her husband, Kinjiro SUNADA, file #7150, and one daughter, Katsushi, one year old.

The deceased signed a Custodian "No Property" card on April 30, 1942, and no assets belonging to her have come to light.

A claim in the amount of \$50.00 was filed against the Estate of the deceased by the B. C. Security Commission to cover funeral expenses paid by the Commission in connection with her burial. They were advised by this office that neither she nor her husband had any assets from which to pay the claim.


