The following claims were lodged against Saemon TATEBE:

1. Dr. M. Uchida - \$3.00.
This claim was later withdrawn by Dr. Uchida.
2. Sakuhei IZUKAWA - \$4.10
In a letter on file dated February 22, 1947, TATEBE remitted the sum of \$2.81 which he requested that we pay, together with the small balance of \$1.29 standing to his credit with the Custodian, to Sakuhei IZUKAWA. Accordingly, by requisition dated March 5th 1947, the above funds were transferred from Tatebe's account to that of Sakuhei Izukawa, thus settling this claim in full.
3. C.K. Blakney (Judgment) - \$241.00 plus costs
On writing to TATEBE in connection with payment of this judgment he stated he was getting old and was unable to pay this debt. A note added to a copy of the judgment on file states "Plaintiff has asked us to drop this claim." No further action has been taken by the Custodian.
