Dear Sir:

On March 31st we purchased from K. Uno, 305 West 4th Ave., Vancouver, B. C., 10 shares B. C. Telephone Company Limited 6% Preferred stock, registered jointly in the name of K. Uno and T. M. Fijita, and issued a cheque to Mr. Uno in full settlement. This security went to the B. C. Telephone Company for transfer and Mr. Boyce advised us on April 2, 1942, that a stop transfer order had been placed against this security and he suggested that we get in touch with you.

We have had various transactions with Mr. Uno in the past, the most recent being the purchase from him on March 14 of 10 shares B. C. Electric Power and Gas Co., Ltd., 6% Preferred stock, at which time there was no difficulty in effecting transfer.

Therefore, we shall be grateful if you will advise us what procedure is necessary to transfer the B. C. Telephone stock, particularly in view of the fact that we have already made payment to Mr. Uno.
