


LIABILITIES:

The Department was advised as April 18th, 1946 that no assets of Einosuke NISHIDA and his wife were revealed on the file. No further action was taken

A Claim was filed by T. MAIKAWA STORES LTD. for \$14.69 . The file does not indicate that this claim was submitted to Einosuke NISHIDA for payment. As Nishida has now been repatriated and as he has no evidence of assets on the file no submission of the Claim is now being made.

No other claims are revealed on the file.
