Although there is a JP Form on this file, dated May 26, 1942, it is not signed. This man was evacuated on May 3, 1942. He died at Vancouver General Hospital on November 24, 1945.

Bonds: The JP Form on file shows a \$50.00 Victory Bond. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Life Insurance: This file shows two life policies with the Sun Life Assurance Company. One of these #2272899 was on the life of Toshihiro TANAKA (son of this man). On December 3, 1943, we sent to Isaburo TANAKA the Sun Life Assurance cheque for \$39.09 representing full settlement of all claims under this policy.

Sun Life Assurance Policy #2272388 on the life of Isaburo TANAKA. On December 3, 1943, we sent to Isaburo TANAKA the insurance company's cheque for \$30.07, representing full settlement of all claims under this policy.



For your information, Mr. Tanaka died on November 24th, at Vancouver.

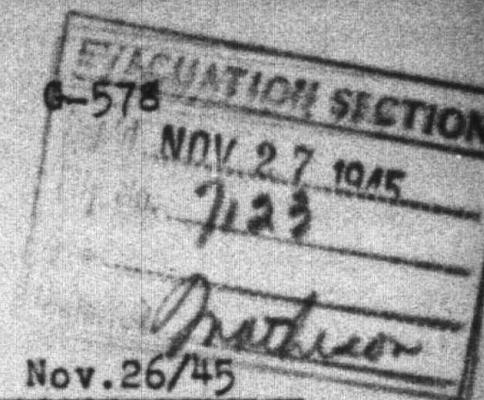
