Dear Sir:

As requested by you, your camera was sent to you by insured parcel post on October 15, 1945. The cost of mailing was 16 cents, which has been paid from the 50 cents sent by you for this purpose. The balance of 34 cents is returned to you herewith in the form of postage stamps.

In your declaration to the Custodian you stated that you owned no property of any kind left in the protected area. However, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police reported to this office that a camera had been surrendered by you. This was confirmed by the receipt which you sent to this office on September 26, and the camera has now been shipped to you.

It is felt that we have accounted for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge receipt of the camera and the sum of 34 cents in stamps, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
