Your file has been reviewed and the following is noted.

On April 29th, 1942, you registered with the Custodian and stated that you owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of British Columbia. However, on January 25th, 1943, you claimed that two bureaus containing clothes, were stored at R. R. #4, New Westminster. As your original declaration gave the address as 397 Sandell Road, Surrey, which was the residence of your father, we assume you left these articles with him, and they would be administered under his name.

Your six-20 Brownie camera, surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police on August 3rd, 1942, was returned to you by mail on April 10th, 1946. The postage and packing charges amounted to eighteen cents, and as you forwarded the sum of fifty cents to cover these costs, we enclose herewith a refund of thirty two cents.
