GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Seki NAKAUCHI, Reg. No. 06525

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 29, 1942. She was evacuated on August 31, 1942.

In her declaration Mrs. NAKAUCHI stated that she owned no property of any kind in the protected area.

The chattels of this woman and her husband are dealt with in the husband's file (File No. 5142), which shows that everything of any particular was shipped to them at the request of Mrs. NAKAUCHI or of her husband. Saleable goods remaining after shipments were made were sold and the net proceeds (\$8.85) were credited to the account of the husband, Yasutaro NAKAUCHI.

The sum of \$123.25 was credited to the account of Seki NAKAUCHI in full settlement of a loan made to her son-in-law, Shunichi ISOKI, File 8771, prior to his departure for Japan.

This file reveals no other property of any kind whatsoever.

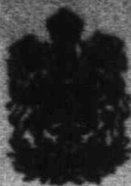
