Dear Madam:

We are in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant asking for an explanation of a cheque for \$5.10 which you have received.

This cheque was attached to our letter of the 19th ultimo, which was self-explanatory. We enclose a copy of this letter and would be obliged if you would let us know whether or not you received the original as we want to follow up the matter if you did not.

The Provincial Income Tax Law under which 1% (sometimes referred to as the "Jones Tax") was deducted from wages at source was rescinded as from 1/1/1941 and the 1% deductions made between January and June, 1941 became refundable. The \$5.10 referred to above represents this refund, received by us from the Provincial Income Tax department for your account.
