DEAR SIR:

On March 15th I wrote to the Provincial Comptroller of the Income Tax Branch concerning a refund of 1% deductions for the period, January 1st to June 30th, 1941. They advised me to write to you regarding this. In 1941 I worked a period from May 15th to Sept 9th. During this period I believe \$149 from my earnings of about \$450 was deducted for this 1% tax. At that time my address was at 341 C. Hastings St. Vancouver, B.C. and my employer was the B.C. Pulp and Paper Co. at Woodfibre. Please look into this matter.
