PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Miss Fumie MINAMIDE, Reg. No. 14236

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 29th, 1942. She was evacuated on May 5th, 1942.

In her declaration she stated that she had no property of any kind in the protected area. There is no evidence that she actually did own any property but on March 8th, 1943, we were informed that Mr. Charles Flick of Mayne Island had shipped a radio to Miss MINAMIDE. This office has no other information in regard to this radio.

The sum of \$861.43, representing 1/3 of the estate of her deceased father, Mr. Bungoro MINAMIDE, File No. 5141, was paid in to this office by the Official Administrator and this sum was credited to her account.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

MEMORANDUM: File 7216

Re: Fumi MINAMIDE, #14236

There is no record of the radio belonging to this person, other than that contained in this file.

With reference to letter of March 11, 1943, which reads, "the Custodian has not yet undertaken the shipment of cameras and radios", etc. While this may have been correct, nevertheless, at that time, arrangements were in progress to have the B. C. Security Commission take delivery from the R.C.M.P. of radios and cameras, where requests for shipment were received from owners residing outside British Columbia, and to make shipment in the same manner as shipment was made of other chattels and personal effects. Release was with the approval of the Custodian, of course.

The Orders in Council, under which "specified articles" were surrendered to the police and held in custody, applied only to the Protected Area of the Pacific Coast. The purchase by, and shipment to, persons of Japanese origin living outside the Protected Area has not been prohibited at any time.

Col. Charles Flick may have been guilty of an infraction of regulations in concealing the fact that he had in his possession property belonging to a person of Japanese origin. But we have no way of knowing whether the radio in question was a gift from Col. Flick to a former employee, or whether he merely acted a purchasing agent for Miss Minamide in regard to the radio. And, as stated, neither action would be contrary to any regulation.

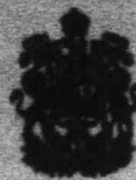
