This 51-year old Naturalized-Canadian Housewife, from Hayne Island, signed a Custodian "No Property" card on the 29th April, 1942. She was evacuated on the 5th May, 1942.

Her late husband, Toru (File 5158), who died at Magrath, Alta., on the 2nd February, 1945, signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on the 21st April, 1942, and was evacuated from Hayne Island on the 5th May, 1942.



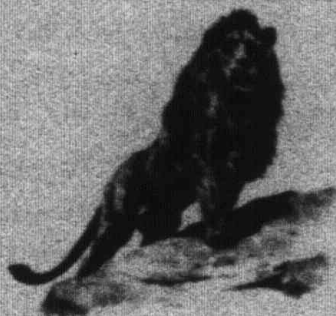



Dear Madam:

We are enclosing herewith cheque of The Monarch Life Assurance Company, in your favour, amounting to \$4,867.05, in full settlement of all claims under the above noted policy on the life of your deceased husband.

We have been advised by The Monarch Life Assurance Company that you will be entitled to an additional sum of \$224.25 if further proof of your husband's age is forwarded to them. They have written us as follows:

"With reference to your letter of the 20th of February, 1945 we enclose herewith a cheque for \$4867.05 in favour of Soms Kadonaga, beneficiary under the above policy. We enclose also a Discharge Form which is to be completed by Soms Kadonaga and returned to this office as acknowledgment of a full settlement under above policy.

The only evidence of Age of Toru Kadonaga which we hold on file is the Marriage Certificate of Toru Kadonaga showing his Age at the time of marriage on June 23, 1911 as 23 years. It would appear from this Certificate that Toru Kadonaga was born in the year 1887 although the date of birth declared in the original application of Insurance was stated to be the 9th of September, 1888 and consequently the above policy was issued on 30th of December 1933 in the basis of 45 years of age.

In view of the evidence now submitted we are required to make an adjustment in the amount of insurance monies payable and the enclosed cheque has been calculated to cover the amount of Insurance in relation to the premiums

paid which would have been purchased by the deceased on the basis of 45 years of age. Adjustments have also been made in respect to the Dividends paid.

If, however, the beneficiary is able to produce further satisfactory evidence to show the date of birth of Toru Kadonaga as the 5th of September 1908 we shall be pleased to reopen this case and make further payment of \$224.25 which is the amount of assurance payable on the basis of 45 years of age as at date of issue.

We are enclosing herewith the Discharge Form, which we would ask you to kindly complete and return to this office for forwarding to the Monarch Life Assurance Company, together with any further evidence you may have in regard to the age of your deceased husband.

Please, also, acknowledge receipt of the enclosed cheque.

We are in receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo and note contents.

When distribution of funds is to be made, a cheque covering same should be forwarded to this office with a notation as to the share each Beneficiary is to receive.

The Mayne Island property was sold to the Soldier Settlement Board and the Director, Veterans' Land Act, as at January 1, 1944. According to our records, and as far as we are aware, the equipment and furniture owned by the deceased were in his name prior to and at the date of his decease.
