

Under date of March 25, 1946 we received a letter from The Prudential Insurance Company advising that the above Japanese person had requested the cash surrender value of Policies 383131319-321 issued on the lives of her sons, Yukio Tsuji and Yoshiake Tsuji, cash surrender value of the policies being \$27.40 and \$26.74 respectively. (Both sons are minors). We stated in our letter to them of March 29, 1946 that we had no objection to these payments being made direct to Mrs. Tsuji but asked that they forward two copies of their letter to this Evacuee to this office for our information, one copy to be sent to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division. On April 8, 1946 copies of the Prudential Insurance letter to the Japanese enclosing the cheques were received by this office.

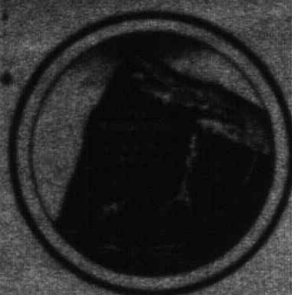
