GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Seiji NISHIZEKI - Reg. No. 14432

BONDS & INVESTMENTS: The above Japanese registered with this office on the 1st May, 1942, and at that time, declared he had \$20.00 in War Savings Certificates, but these were not brought under control by the Custodian.

Although he did not declare so, he was the holder of 18 non-redeemable shares in the Pacific Co-operative Union, and interest in the amount of 18¢ has been credited to his account from these shares from time to time totalling 54¢.

LIFE INSURANCE: NISHIZEKI also declared having a Life Insurance policy in the North American Life, and also a Crown Life Policy.

The North American Life remitted the following dividends on paid up premiums on his policy, through this office, and these were forwarded to NISHIZEKI:-

15th April, 1944	\$3.49
4th Jan. 1945	.56
17th Jan. 1946	.63


The North American Life and Crown Life advised us on the 15th September, 1945 and the 9th February, 1946, respectively, that NISHIZEKI had applied for the cash surrender value of his policies. However, as NISHIZEKI owed the Ruskin Box Company the sum of \$50.00, he was advised that it would be necessary for him to authorise payment of this account before the money could be remitted to him from this office. On the 26th February, 1946, authorisation was received from both NISHIZEKI and his wife, Misao NISHIZEKI, File No. 2251, as she was beneficiary under these policies, and payment of the Ruskin Box Company account was made in full 7th March, 1946. On the same date, the North American Life Insurance Company's cheque of \$174.34, and the balance of the Crown Life Insurance Company cheque after payment of the claim (\$140.99 less \$50.00) - \$90.99 was forwarded to Mr. and Mrs. NISHIZEKI.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: The Provincial Government refunded the sum of \$4.32, being on his 1941 Provincial Income Tax.

This file reveals no other personal property assets or liabilities.



Thank you very much indeed for your letter dated July 2nd particularly in connection with claim filed with us against you of \$50.00 by the Ruskin Box Company. From the general tone of your letter it appears to us that you agree with the correctness of the amount claimed but you indicate also that you are not in the position to effect settlement. The Ruskin Box Company have forwarded us a promissory note signed by you as proof of the amount they had claimed against you. For the sake of regularity we would appreciate your confirming to us the correctness of the amount in question.

At the present time you have a credit balance with the Custodian amounting to only \$4.32.
