First year I went to Minto there wasn't any decent works for us and were at the self supporting. In order to eat ourselves well at first we have to work so I worked for him but he doesn't make payment for us and I asked so many times so he just gave me \$20 at first but not the rest. It's almost 3 years since I worked for him.

Last year about October we moved from Minto to the places called Midway and I can't ~~find~~ get the money from him so would you please write to him and ask for the money which he owes me and would you tell him that I want the money immediately.
